Dear Mayor Gray:

As you are aware, I am the Chairman of the D.C. Police Union: Fraternal Order of Police, Metropolitan Police Department Labor Committee (FOP). The FOP represents the approximately 3500 police officer, detectives, and sergeants of the Metropolitan Police Department. I am writing regarding the assertions and comments you made during an interview on NewsTalk with Bruce DePuyt on December 15, 2011 (available online at: <http://www.tbd.com/blogs/news-talk/2011/12/our-interview-with-mayor-gray-13957.html>).

During the interview you were asked questions about the Occupy D.C. protest and its impact on police resources and the current rate of crime. You made a number of misrepresentations and also provided misleading or deceptive answers with regard to the Metropolitan Police Department and crime in the District, including, but not limited to, denying the use of patrol personnel to cover the Occupy D.C. protests, the effect the redeployment of officers has had on crime in the District, and the number of current and future police officers on the Metropolitan Police Department.

Public awareness and adequate resources (e.g., manpower, technology, equipment, community outreach, etc.) are key components of public safety. The residents of the District of Columbia, its visitors, and those that work here deserve to have honest information about crime in the District. If we are not honest with the public about the level of crime, then it is difficult to properly protect everyone, because resources are not being properly allocated, awareness campaigns cannot be implemented, we cannot confront entrenched problems, and we cannot respond quickly to spikes in crime. As importantly, if we are not honest about the problems we are facing as a police department and a government, then we are not putting the resources where they need to be and we cannot turn to the public and the legislature and justify more resources if necessary.

By providing the public misinformation about crime and the Department you have done a disservice to this city and are contributing to the problem. The FOP is requesting that you formally amend the record by issuing a statement identifying and correcting your misleading

comments, and apologizing for the misinformation you provided. For your convenience, below I have identified the statements in need of correction, the time in the interview that such statements were made, and I have provided documentation in support of the true facts.

CRIME RATES AND OCCUPY D.C.

At the 30-minute, 23-second mark of the program Mr. DePuyt asked about the redirection of officers from patrolling neighborhoods to monitor Occupy D.C. Mr. DePuyt read a portion of an e-mail from me, questioning that strategy:

Crime is up, the number of officers are down, and what little resources we have are being directed to monitor Occupy D.C. Why has the Mayor not warned the residents about this problem?

In your response, you said, "I am not sure what I should warn them about, first of all." And when specifically asked about crime being up since the Occupy D.C. protest began, you responded: "I'm not sure about the statement about crime being up."

As you are aware, on the date of your interview violent crime in the District was up by 13 percent and total crime was up by 10 percent since Occupy D.C. began on October 1, 2011, compared to the same time period the year before, according to the Metropolitan Police Department (Attachment 1). In addition, the increase in violent crime and all crime has accelerated as Occupy D.C. has continued. On the date of your interview, violent crime over the past 30 days had increased by a stunning 17 percent and overall crime was up by 14 percent (Attachment 2). These numbers are year to date comparisons, so they account for the holiday spike in crime – this is a dramatic increase on top of the holiday spike. (I would note that the problem continues to worsen; as of December 26, 2011, violent crime over the past 30 days was up 21 percent and overall crime was up 18 percent, see Attachment 3.)

Your failure to warn District residents about a double digit spike in violent crime is inexcusable. The public has a right to know when crime is increasing and public awareness can facilitate crime prevention. As the FOP made clear with your one-term predecessor, risking public safety for political advantage is not an acceptable practice.

THE USE OF NEIGHBORHOOD POLICE OFFICERS AT OCCUPY D.C.

Your political motive for not wanting to acknowledge growing problems with crime is obvious. As Chairman of the Council of the District of Columbia you were responsible for legislating three budgets that cut the number of police officer positions by 400. As studies have demonstrated (here in D.C. in fact), less police officers means more crime. (See Jonathon Klick and Alexander Tabarrok, *Using Terror Alert Levels to Estimate the Effect of Police on Crime*, *The Journal of Law and Economics*, volume 48, April, 2005.) The increase in crime overall and violent crime during the Occupy D.C. protest is but one of the negative results of the Department having 400 fewer police officers, and officers being taken out of the neighborhoods in order to monitor Occupy D.C.

Rather than acknowledging the use of neighborhood patrol officers to monitor Occupy D.C., your response was, at best, misleading. When asked at the 32-minute, 5-second mark about the need to send manpower from the patrol districts to handle situations where protesters block street during rush hour your answer was. "Pretty unlikely Bruce, we have a Special Operations Division within the police department which focuses on these kind of things." At the 33-minute, 5-second mark you claimed to be unaware of "any situation where a neighborhood has been neglected because we have had to deal with the protestors." Both statements are unsupported by the facts. Not only are neighborhood patrol officers being utilized for active protests, but also, officers are being taken out of the neighborhoods on a daily basis to passively monitor the Occupy D.C. areas because Special Operations Division (SOD) does not have enough police officers to handle that responsibility.

In fact, prior to your interview, on December 7, 2011, the entire Department had to be held over from the day work tour of duty because of the Occupy D.C. actions (Attachment 4). This included Civil Disturbance Units (seven officers and one sergeant per shift) and prisoner transports from all seven police district. So not only was it not "[p]retty unlikely" that neighborhood officers would be used for Occupy D.C. protests, but it had already occurred when you made that statement.

More importantly, because of the lack of manpower neighborhood officers are being sent down to monitor Occupy D.C. to augment SOD on a daily basis; an issue you claimed to not exist. Like you, Chief Cathy Lanier also has publicly denied such redeployment of officers (see, Ask the Chief, WTOP, December 1, 2011, <http://www.wtop.com/?nid=614&sid=2653257&pid=0&page=2>). The FOP, however, has obtained copies of Deployment Accountability Logs (Logs) showing neighborhood patrol officers being routinely assigned to monitor Occupy D.C. on a daily basis prior to your interview and Chief Lanier's interview. While the Department has not produced all of the Logs, the Logs that have been produced show anywhere from 2 to 18 neighborhood patrol officers per shift being assigned out of their Patrol Service Area and to Occupy D.C. each day (Attachment 5).

In normal times, the loss of even one officer can have an impact on neighborhood policing. That impact is being magnified because of your decision to cut 400 police positions. Losing 2 or 3 officers per shift in a district is devastating, because our numbers are so low that some districts are down to only 3 officers per shift (see, e.g., Harry Jaffe, *Falling homicide rate masks D.C.'s crime problem*, Washington Examiner, December 16, 2011).

THE NUMBER OF POLICE OFFICERS

In your response to the e-mail and Mr. DePuyt's question regarding the number of officers, at the 31-minute mark you answered that the current budget authorized the addition of 300 officers to the Department, stating:

One of the things in the budget was we have in this budget hiring 300 new police officers and that process started in October, what we will have in the end is replacing all the police officers how

leave, about 15 or so per month who leave and adding 120 to the overall complement of officers here in the District of Columbia.

Your statement asserting the Department will add 120 police officers is unsupported by the facts. Your plan to replace and add police officers was based on an attrition rate of 13 to 15 officers a month and hiring 30 officers per month (see, e.g., Freeman Klopott, *Gray says D.C. has the money to hire more cops*, Washington Examiner, June 29, 2011, and Liz Farmer, *D.C. police reopening training academy*, Washington Examiner, September 28, 2011).

As you know, the current rate of attrition is significantly higher. In fact, the most recent numbers provided by the Department show that between September 7 and December 3, 2011, 64 officers left the Department in 88 days (see Attachment 6, redacted Metropolitan Police Department Separation Report). That is an attrition rate of over 21 officers per month.

In addition, the Department has already failed to meet or even come close to its hiring goals of 30 officers per month. As of the date of your interview, the Department had only managed to hire two recruit classes with a total of 50 new hires. On December 19, 2011, another class was hired with fewer than 20 officers. Assuming even limited attrition since December 3, 2011, the Department is at or below the number of officers it had at the beginning of September 2011. Given the actual rate of attrition and pace of hiring, any assertion to the public that the Department will increase by 120 officers by the end of the fiscal year 2012 is misleading at best.

THE LEVEL OF CRIME IN THE DISTRICT

In your response about the level of crime in the District at the 31-minute, 17-second mark you provided crime statistics for homicides in the District of Columbia, but failed to mention or even acknowledge the fact that overall crime in the District is up for 2011 according to the Metropolitan Police Department. In fact, you concluded your answer by saying that “the statistics bear out the fact that we are going in the right direction.” The truth, however, is that property and overall crime is down across the country and the District is going in the opposite direction of the national trends. (See, e.g., Associated Press, *FBI reports violent and property crime down in the first half of the year*, Washington Post, December 19, 2011.)

In September of this year the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) released the crime numbers for 2010. As you know, the FOP has repeatedly questioned the assertions by Chief Lanier and Mayor Adrian Fenty (repeated by certain members of the media) that crime had decreased in the District under Mayor Fenty, particularly the assertion that it had decreased “dramatically.” The release of the FBI's crime numbers last month for calendar year 2010 supports what the FOP has said all along: overall crime rose under Mayor Fenty and Chief Lanier, and continued to rise last year.

Overall crime in the city did not decrease, let alone decrease dramatically. Certainly, during the four years from 2006 to 2010, specific types of crimes, such as motor vehicle thefts, have decreased, but at the same time, other crimes, such as burglary, have increased. The numbers reflect an increase in the majority of the crime categories and an increase in the amount of Overall Crime. Under the FBI standards there are 7 categories of crime – Total Violent Crime

and Total Property Crime are the totals of those 7 respective crime categories. During Mr. Fenty's tenure there was an increase in rape, robbery, burglary, and thefts – 4 of the 7 crime categories. The summary shows that overall crime rose from 34,423 incidents in 2006 (the year before Mr. Fenty became mayor) to 34,606 incidents in 2010 (the last year of his administration). The tables are available at <http://www.fbi.gov/about-us/cjis/ucr/>.

What is particularly concerning is that even based on the Department's own crime numbers, which are different than the numbers provided to the FBI (a practice you vowed to end as Mayor, as addressed more fully below), the Department's crime numbers for 2011 already show that overall crime is up 2% city-wide. (It is important to realize that when the real numbers for 2011 are submitted to the FBI, that number is likely to increase substantially.)

While the FOP is extremely pleased that homicides and other crimes have decreased in the District (as they have nationally), we are greatly concerned that other crimes have continued to increase, particularly given that those increases are the opposite of national trends. The fact that the Chief of Police and now, the Mayor, are not openly discussing those increases with the public is alarming. If you honestly believe that having increased rates of crime when crime is declining everywhere else means we are "going in the right direction," then there is a major problem.

Being honest with the public about the level of crime in the District is critical. Creating a false sense of security or not being forthright about the actual amount of crime can have disastrous long term effects.

THE USE OF TWO SETS OF CRIME NUMBERS

Finally, as mentioned above, you campaigned against the use of two sets of crime numbers and expressed concern over the fact that the Department created a second set of crime numbers to provide to the public. Unfortunately, you now appear to be using information from that second set of crime numbers when providing information to the public, just like Mayor Fenty did. The second set of crime numbers does not match the legally required information provided to the FBI. That second set of crime numbers, specifically tailored by Chief Lanier, has been used to argue that crime is down in the District. The truth is that the total number of crimes reported to the FBI is greater than the second set of crime numbers. For example, in 2010, the Department reported 8004 violent crimes to the FBI, but on its own website it reported only 7048 violent crimes to the public, and for property crimes 28,756 were reported to the FBI but only 24,196 on its website (see, e.g., <http://www.fbi.gov/about-us/cjis/ucr/crime-in-the-u.s/2010/crime-in-the-u.s.-2010/tables/10tbl04.xls> and <http://crimemap.dc.gov/presentation/report.asp>).

What happened to those over 5,500 crimes? Is anyone investigating them? How is excluding existence of 5,500 crimes from the public providing better information? Are the victims of those crimes less important? At what point did the police department, an executive agency, gain the power to ignore crimes as defined by the United States Congress and the Council of the District of Columbia?

The use of the second set of crime numbers appears indefensible, but it is particularly hard to understand given that when Chief Lanier negotiated her employment contract with the District, she negotiated a provision for a mandatory bonus based on a reduction in crime. The basis of determining her eligibility for a bonus is the numbers provided to the FBI. No one has yet explained why the FBI numbers are appropriate for determining whether crime was down for purposes of Chief Lanier's bonus, but inappropriate for providing accurate information to the public.

As part of your response, the FOP is requesting that you respond to the above questions on the second set of crime numbers and clarify whether you are using the FBI crime numbers or the second set of crime numbers when talking about crime.

CONCLUSION

As noted above, the FOP is requesting that you issue a statement identifying and correcting your misleading comments, and apologizing for the misinformation you provided. This would include: 1) your failure to address, or even acknowledge, the startling increase in crime, particularly violent crime, over the past few months; 2) the misrepresentations about the use of police resources and manpower as it relates to Occupy D.C. and the impact that it has had on the crime rates in the District; 3) your misrepresentations about the number of police officers, current and future, on the Metropolitan Police Department; 4) your failure to address the increase in overall crime in the District, particularly given the national trends; and 5) clarification on your position as to the two sets of crime numbers, including answers to the questions raised above.
